“Bagpipe Luthier”

DIDACTIC PLAN

Aims:

- Learn about a specific part of Galician culture: folk music and its instruments.
- Reflect on the craftsman job, focusing in the luthier work.
- Show how bagpipes are made, starting from the very first steps (trees and woods) to the last ones.
- Understand our way of living, connecting it with other folklores in Europe.

Contents and activities:

In this workshop/seminar we visited Seivane´s workshop. This bagpipe´s luthier workshop is the most important one in Spain, earning the most important prices and having requests from all around the world. Firstly, we started with a short video, where our guests could learn about basic aspects of the bagpipes and how the luthier job is. After that, we could see the different woods, where they come from, where they are preserved and why. We have been thought about the different steps in turning these woods into a life sound. Finally, some students and teachers could play a bagpipe, and we talk about their importance in Galician folklore.
