

## **RESOLVING CONFLICTS: PEER TO PEER MEDIATION**

*Workshop, seminar or session title:*

### **“Reports on school environment surveys”**

#### **DIDACTIC PLAN**

This was a preliminary activity that the students and teachers had to prepare before the meeting. We sent each country some surveys (for students, teachers and families) to fill in to collect data about the environment situation in each school (type of conflicts, frequency, age of students, groups, etc.)

#### *Aims:*

- Make the students be aware of the conflicts they usually have at their schools.
- Identify the type of conflicts each school has.
- Think about how all these conflicts should be solved.

#### *Contents and activities:*

In this workshop the students from each country had to show the results of the surveys about school environment sent beforehand. In their presentations they explained and reflected on the habitual conflicts they have in their high school. They also showed the results of the surveys made by their families. After that we tried to pool and reflect on the data provided as well as identify the common conflicts.

#### *Timing:*
