### Students' feedback

- nice hotel
- good to have built teams in advance
- freetime activities individually possible
- highlight of the week was Kiaras presentation
  
- fluency of English amongst students diverged too much → communication was a problem and sometimes hardly possible
  
- timetable too vague
  
- guided tour in Rome might have been better prepared
  
- the advertisement for the products didn't leave enough time for the actual topic of the week „being an entrepreneur“
  
- it was difficult to include every student into the working process of the Erasmus community

### Teachers' feedback

- timetable didn't work out well → delays and confusions about responsibilities
- timetable should be updated when necessary and handed out to both teachers and students
- groups didn't have comparable numbers of participants
- students applying for the project should be chosen according to their motivation and English skills
- welcome sessions should introduce the aim and planned schedule of the workshop and explain the link to the general outcome of the whole project
- the issues of the workshop week should have been given to the students in advance for better preparation, e.g. via e-guide
- keep up to the students' presentations of the final results
- but students should be equipped with appropriate methods to evaluate these presentations and to give a feedback
- If activities are directly connected with the workshop, this connection should be explained in advance and reflected afterwards.
- A general feedback session seems absolutely necessary.
- guided tours should be done in small groups for greater effectiveness
