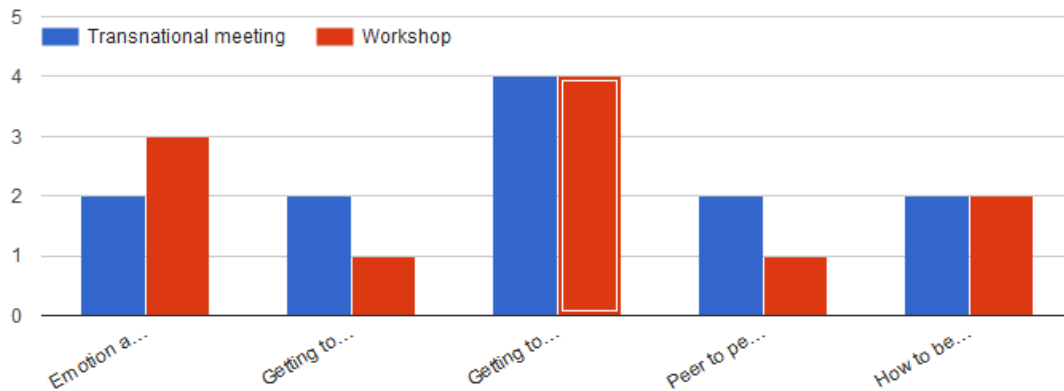

Strengthening of our school profile, international exchange and increase the intercultural competences and language skills for teachers and students, meet people from different countries

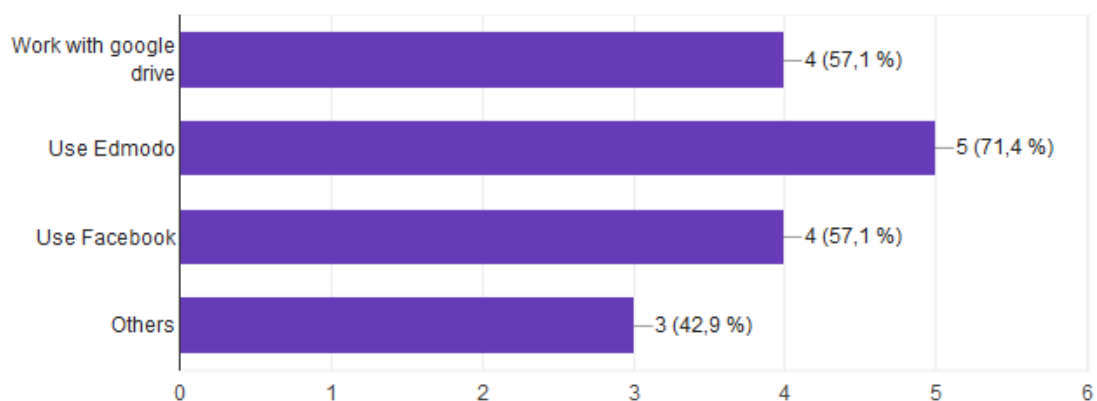

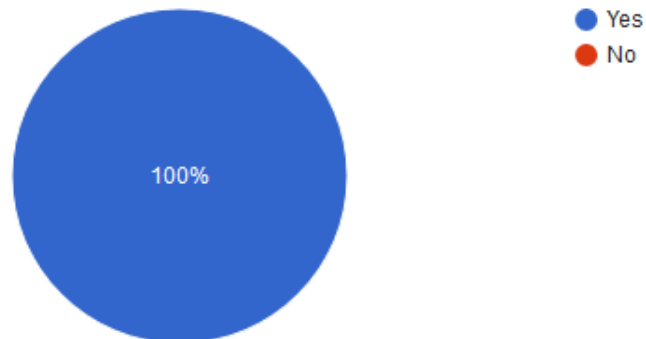

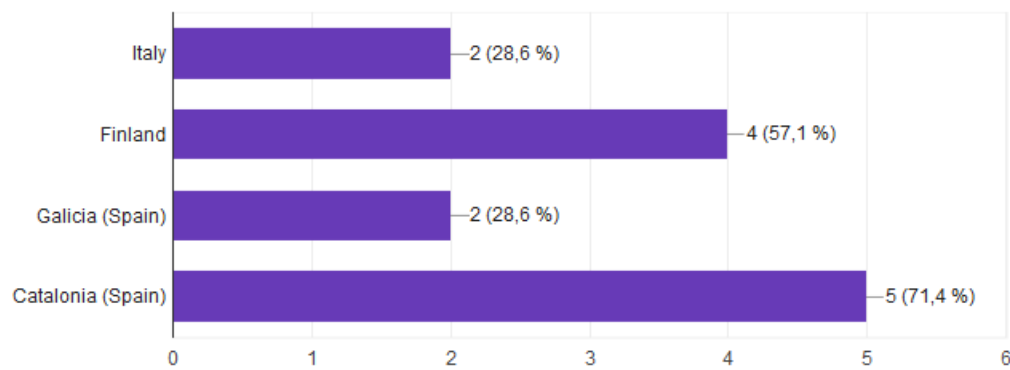

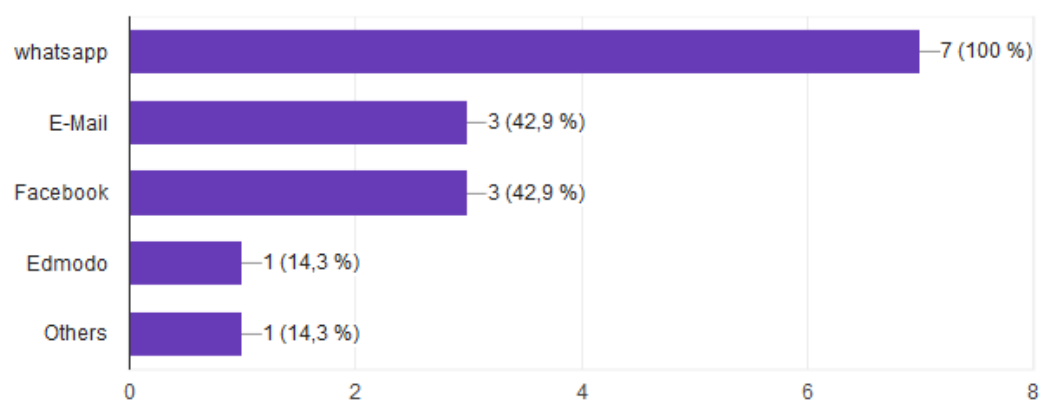

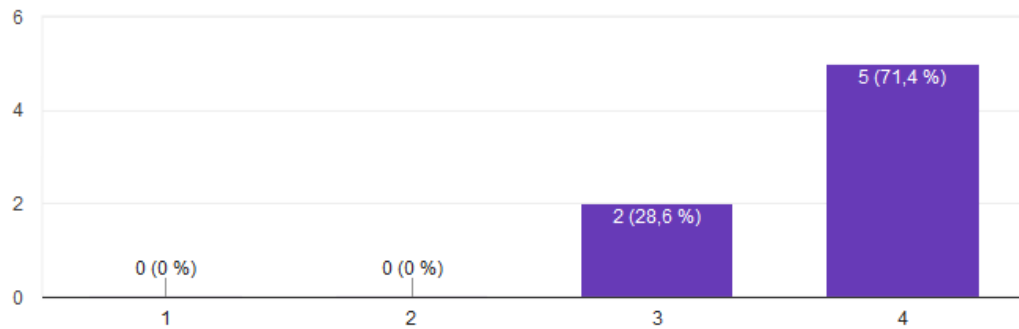

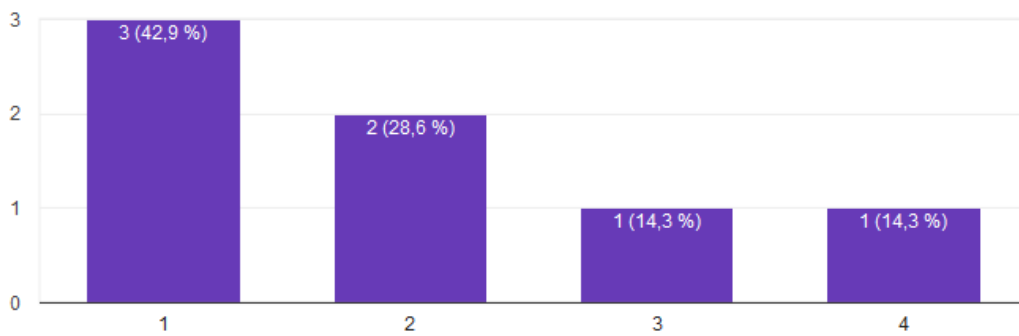

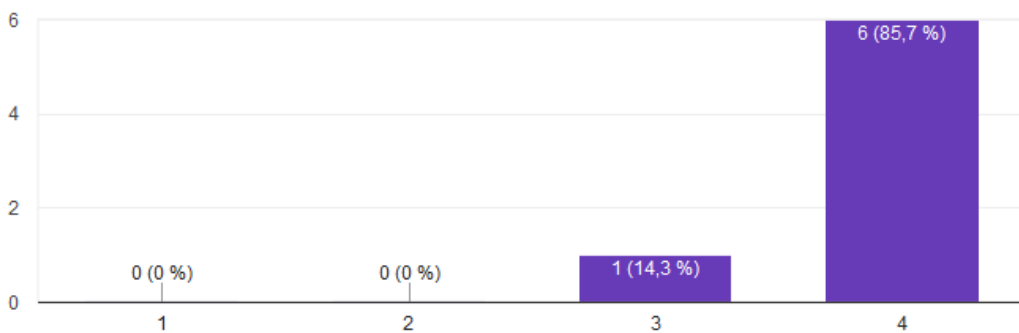

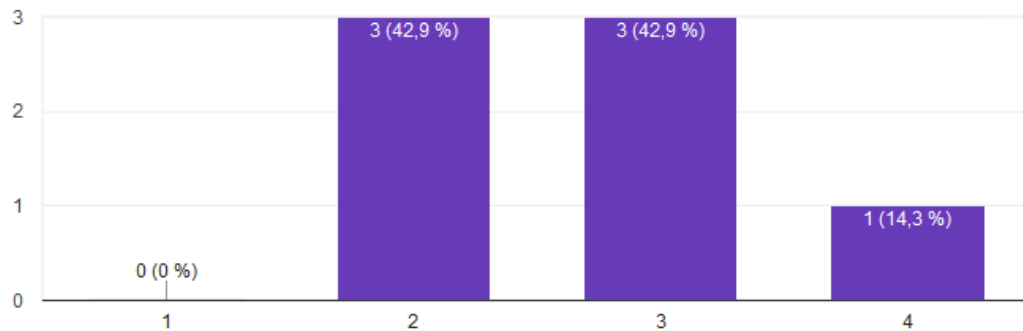

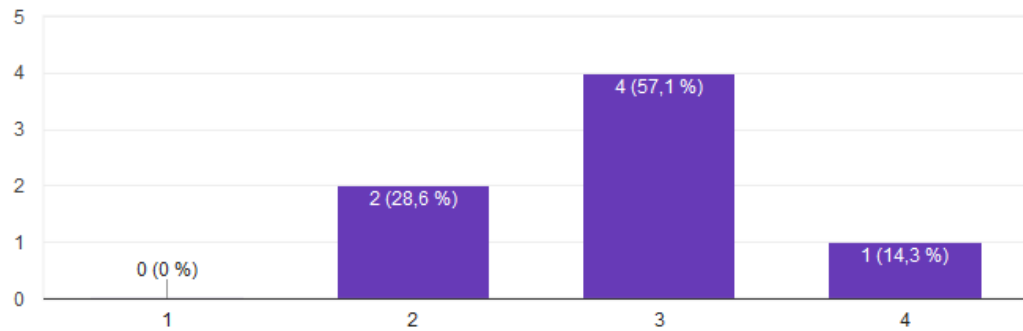

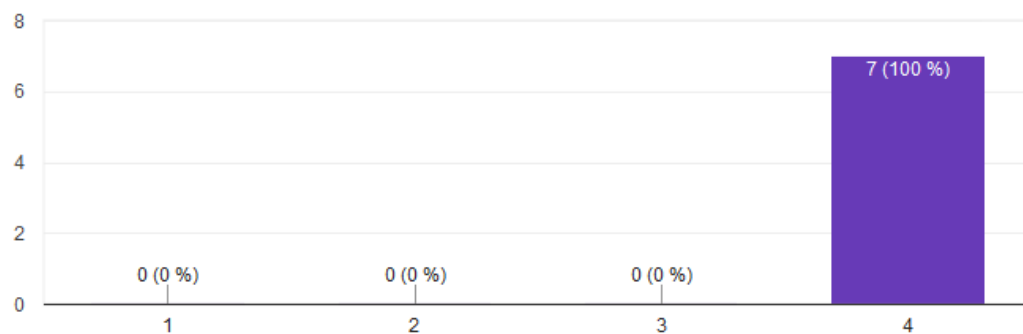

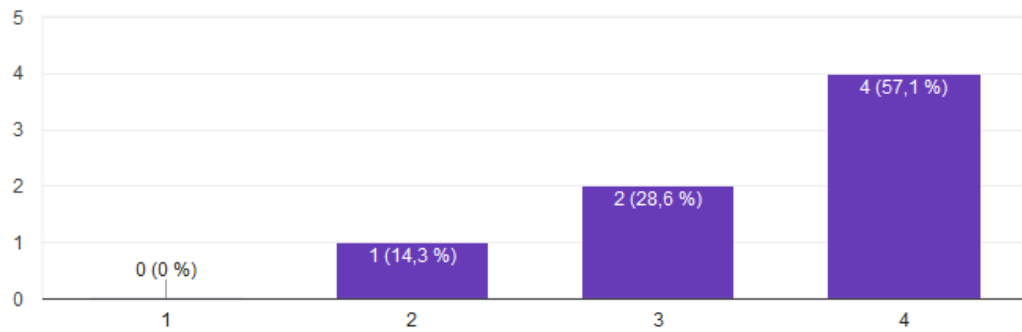

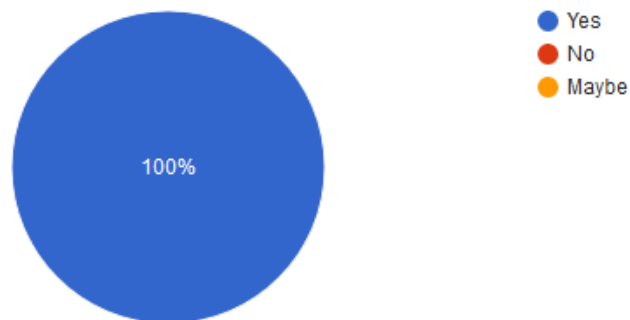

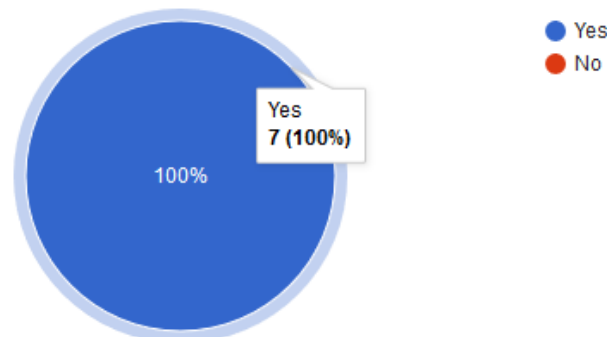
